- 🪙 Dues go towards creating resources for the building and chartering of new clubs
- 🪙 They go towards the Youth Opportunity Fund (YOF) which awards grants to clubs for large-scale service projects
- 🪙 They support the Key Club International website as well as District websites
- 🪙 They aid in convention planning
- 🪙 They fund administration, supplies and services (e.g. membership cards, pins, printing, etc.)
- 🪙 They support the Key Club magazine They help pay insurance
